Pharmaniaga on track for 6% growth

SHAH ALAM: Pharmaniaga Bhd is on track to achieve its key performance indicator (KPI) target of 6% revenue growth this year, its chairman Datuk Azman Yanya said yesterday.

He said to achieve this, the company was continuing to focus on its Malaysian and Indonesian operations.

The company registered a revenue of RM1.31 billion last year, up 10.3% from RM1.18 billion in 2007.

"We will make every effort to achieve the KPI target," Azman told reporters after the company's annual general meeting (AGM) yesterday.
